When an official function is taking place the gate will remain open until the function has concluded.

If players expect to be at the Club past the above stated times, cars must be parked outside the gate to avoid being locked in.

Payment Requirements

Subscriptions are payable in advance on the anniversary date of your membership each year.

Subscriptions may be **paid in full** in advance of the anniversary date each year or by **Direct Debit** (quarterly/monthly or fortnightly) from a nominated bank account. Such instalments will attract a surcharge. Every member must have either paid their subscription in full or have a direct debit arrangement with the Club by their anniversary date each year.

Any member who has not paid the first instalment within one month of their anniversary date or any subsequent instalment by the end of the month in which it falls due shall have their playing rights suspended from that date. Any member who has not paid their subscription instalment within two months of the due date shall cease to be a member of the Club subject to the Committee's discretion which shall be exercised only in exceptional circumstances.

Membership Category Rules

All playing categories are subject to course availability and playing rights.

7 Day Member – This is an 18 hole membership, 7 days a week.

6 Day Member – This is an 18 hole membership, Sunday to Friday only.

4 Day Weekday Membership – This is a restricted 18 hole membership. Members may play Mon/Tue*/Thur/Fri.

*On a Tuesday this is outside of the Ladies Club Competition tee times.

7 Day 9 Hole – This is a 9 hole membership, 7 days a week.

Senior 9 Hole – This is a 9 hole membership, 7 days a week. Members must be 75 years or over on the date of joining or annual renewal and have been a member of the MGC for a minimum of 10 years.

Under 30 – This is an 18 hole membership, 7 days a week. Members must be 29 years or under on the date of joining.

Under 25 – This is an 18 hole membership, 7 days a week. Members must be 24 years or under on the date of joining.

Full Playing Junior – This is an 18 hole membership, 7 days a week. Members must be 18 years or under on the date of joining.

Restricted Junior – This is a restricted 18 hole membership. Members are unable to play on Club competition days and must be 18 years or under on the date of joining.

Social – This is a non-playing membership. Members are welcome to use the Clubrooms and the practice facilities 7 days a week and receive all Club communications. Non-affiliated green fees apply. Club member discounts for food and beverages are available

All Membership categories are under review annually.

Green Fees for Visitors

Visitors to the Club wishing to play on the golf course must obtain a starting time and pay green fees prior to starting play.

GENERAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES

Logging on to the website

All members have a 7digit Club number, which is displayed on your membership card (237xxxx). This number is used to access the members section of the website.

First you must register at www.golf.co.nz with your 7 digit number. Follow the prompts and choose your password. This will now be your password for logging into member access area of the Manawatu Golf Club website. In this section you can read Club news, access information and book tee times. If you have any problems registering a password or using the website, please contact the Club office.

Personal contact information

Members are encouraged to update personal contact information via the members section of the Club website.

Notices

Members are encouraged to regularly check the Club website for notices relating to Club activities and access to/closure of the course.

Tee Bookings and Starting Sheets

These are accessed via the Club website, or at the computer kiosk in the Cardroom or Café. Please note that if you cannot make a tee time you have booked for any reason you must delete your booking so that another member can use this start time. To achieve best utilisation of the course for our members and guests, the Committee reserves the right to set tee time parameters either on a temporary or a permanent basis. This may include, but is not limited to, setting a handicap limit criteria for tee bookings and playing access during certain periods of the day or week. This will be monitored.

Parking

The car park is available for members and visitors. Cars are parked in the car park at the owners' risk. The area in front of the Pro Shop and Clubhouse is for approved and service vehicles as a loading area, or to drop off/pick up only.

Dress Requirements – IMPORTANT

Course

A neat and tidy standard of dress is required on the course at all times. Collared shirts must be worn. Brief shorts, beach shorts, tights, tank tops, tracksuits/pants or street shoes on the course are not acceptable.

Clubhouse

A neat and tidy standard of dress is required at all times. Hats and golf shoes must be removed before entering the café and bar area.

Club Storage

A limited amount of trundler and club storage is available in the Clubhouse basement for an annual fee of \$175 for a normal trundler and \$200 for a large trundler (limited availability). Members

using this facility are advised that they must cover property under their own insurance. Members wishing to enquire about golf cart storage should contact the Membership Manager.

Golf Cart Rules and Etiquette

These rules and etiquette expectations are designed for your safety and the safety of others, and to protect our golf course and property. If a member wishes to use their own golf cart (or other golf transportation vehicle) on the course, they are required to become a Cart Member. Cart Membership is approved by the Match Committee and may include an inspection of the cart/ vehicle.

Only licensed drivers are permitted to use a golf cart on our course. Limit the use of your cart to two riders, with two golf bags. If you drive your cart in the car park area be especially careful.

Keep your cart away from tee boxes and 10 metres away from the greens. Areas are marked by red lines which show a 'No Cart Zone'.

Follow all Cart Rules displayed in every cart.

To use a Cart on the course, Members must be Cart Members, display the MGC Cart Rules in their Cart and clearly display the cart numbers allocated with membership.

Health & Safety and Emergencies

The Club has comprehensive health and safety procedures. All Staff, Club members and visitors are urged to comply with appropriate requirements and apply common sense rules to protect their own safety and the safety of others. Further guidance on safety while playing golf is set out in the Rules of Golf, Section 1, Etiquette; behaviour on the course. All members are encouraged to report accidents or near misses to the Club office.

All members should acquaint themselves with the Clubhouse emergency evacuation procedures. In an emergency (e.g. fire, earthquake) it is vital that members vacate the Clubhouse in a prompt and orderly manner. After such an event evacuees are asked to remain in the designated assembly area until an all-clear is given.

+A defibrillator is available in the Card room for use to assist any person who suffers a sudden cardiac related collapse. Administration, Café and Pro Shop staff have been trained to use this equipment. **The number to call in an emergency is 06 357 8793 extn 1.**

Smoking is not permitted in any part of the Clubhouse. Smokers are to use the area outside the rear entrance.

Members and visitors enter the golf course at their own risk.

Security, Strangers, Trespassers and Dogs

Cars, golfing equipment and Clubhouse property are occasionally targets for break in and theft. All members should ensure that cars are locked; attractive items kept out of sight and a watch kept for strangers acting suspiciously on any part of the

Club's property. All strangers having no right to be on the course should be asked to leave.

Dogs are not permitted on the course except on designated 'Golf with Dogs' day that will be advertised to the members.

Closure of the Course

The course may be closed from time to time due to ground conditions, course maintenance requirements or for other reasons. In such cases this is indicated on the MGC Course Status Sign near the entrance and a notice placed on the Club website.

No play is allowed when the course is closed. When the course is closed the practice greens and putting greens are also closed.

The Range usually remains open, even when the course is closed.

Relationships with Staff

Mutual respect and understanding is the key to good relationships between members and staff.

The kitchen, administration areas, course workshop areas, equipment and Pro Shop office and workshop areas are off-limits to members - except at the specific invitation of those responsible.

Green keeping staff have priority on the course for maintenance purposes, in which case players must wait until greens staff are out of range or wave players through.

Under no circumstances are any members to reprimand any staff members or persons contracted to the Club. Any complaints must be made in writing to the General Manager.

Club Policies

From time to time the Club may implement specific policies on various issues relating to the Club's operation. Some of these issues are mentioned in this booklet, and others are posted on the Notice Board in the Cardroom and on the Club website.

Complaints

All complaints need to be made in writing to the General Manager. Members' complaints must not be taken up directly with staff members.

Golf Etiquette

Section 1 of the “Rules of Golf” provides guidelines on the way the game should be played.

The main headings under the Golf Etiquette section (1) of the Rules of Golf are as follows:

- Introduction
- The Spirit of the Game
- Safety (during play)
- Consideration for other Players
- On the Putting Green
- Scoring
- Pace of Play
- Priority on the Course
- Care of the Course
- Conclusion; Penalties for Breach

All players should familiarise themselves with these guidelines.

Care of the Course

It is essential that players make every endeavour to ensure the course is kept in top order by co-operating as follows:

- Keep to paths where they are provided.
- Do not walk through areas closed off by greens staff.
- Carefully replace divots on fairways and rough.
- Carefully rake bunkers after playing bunker shots. Rakes to be placed outside bunkers.
- Don't take trundlers between greens and greenside bunkers.
- Carefully repair pitch marks on greens using a pitch mark repairing tool.
- Avoid standing close to the hole while attending, removing or replacing the flagstick.
- Don't remove balls from the hole using the blade of a club.

- Observe current policies and notices regarding the use of golf carts.
- Ensure all rubbish is put in the containers provided at each tee.
- Ensure cigarette butts are not left on or around the course, and are disposed of properly.

ARRANGEMENTS AND REGULATIONS FOR PLAY Programme for the Year

This programme booklet is printed for members each year and a live version is available via the Club website. The online version is the most up to date.

Making or Cancelling Tee Bookings

All tee bookings are made on the start sheets accessed via the Club website or using the GolfNZ App, the kiosk in the Cardroom or Café. Any bookings or cancellations on the day of play must be made by the player through the above channels as early as possible by contacting the Pro Shop (phone 06 357 8793 ext 1).

Starting Tees

Starting tees are as allocated on the tee sheet.

Tees in Use

On any day the tees in use will be specified by the Starter. As we have a multi tee system, the starter may specify that players can choose which tee to play from on a certain day.

We now have available the following courses:

Purple (shortest), Green, Orange, White, Red, The PTS Logistics Blue Course, The BMW Championship Black Course (longest).

These are designed for players of all levels to be able to choose the appropriate course for their ability.



President's and Club Captain's Privilege

The President and Club Captain have the right to enter the field whenever they desire.

Arrival at the Course

Players should aim to arrive at the golf course at least 20 minutes before their appointed tee off time and be fully prepared to tee off as soon as the players in front are out of range.

On the day of play, if players are unable to meet their appointed tee off time, they must advise the Pro Shop or Starter with as much advanced warning as possible. Failure to do this is unacceptable since it may deprive another player of a game.

Sharing of Golf Clubs

The sharing of golf clubs is not permitted.

Practicing

Practice areas are available for use by all players. Players practicing on the course proper must not use more than two balls, and greens and tees must not be used for practice.

Handicaps and Records of Previous Rounds

Handicaps and Records of Previous Rounds Handicaps and handicap indices are automatically printed on scorecards.

Details of previous rounds and handicap indices for all members are accessible via the Dot Golf website www.golf.co.nz. Information regarding the World

Handicapping System (WHS) is also available on this site.

The handicapping system is based on the assumption that every player will endeavour to make the best score at each hole in every round that is played and that every round will be reported regardless of where it is played.

A handicap may be arbitrarily reduced if the player does not return all scores or otherwise does not observe the spirit of the handicapping system. The Committee is empowered to determine the amount of the adjustment and in an extreme case of a player's non-co-operation may result in withdrawal of the handicap.

Scorecards

The correct method of keeping the score is that players keep each other's cards or scores using the GolfNZ App by entering the score after each hole.

After completion of all rounds, fully marked and signed scorecards or if you are using the Golf NZ App must show complete entries for all holes.

Immediately after your round your score must be entered on the Golf NZ App or via one of the touch screen monitors located in the Cardroom or Café. Golf Club policy is for the MARKER to enter the player's score into the Golf NZ touchscreen. Only after this process should the scorecard be placed into the return box. If your scorecard is not entered, it will not be uploaded for handicapping.

Always remember that it is the players' responsibility to sign a correct scorecard. Instructions on how to correctly fill out the scorecards are provided in the Cardroom and the Club website. If you are still unsure, please ask.

Speed of Play

All players must ensure that their game is played at a reasonable speed. In general, players should keep up with the players in front. If you are not keeping up with the group in front, please make every effort to catch up, or let the group playing behind you through if you are holding them up.

Complaints of slow play will be recognised only when made and signed by all members of a four playing behind. The Match Committee at their discretion and after interviewing all concerned may impose an appropriate penalty on the slow players. For example, on a subsequent playing day or days the slow players may be relegated to the end of the field or draw.

Hole in One Shouts

Manawatu Golf Club members who achieve a hole in one during a full round of golf at the Manawatu Golf Club are entitled to a contribution from the Club toward the customary shout for a hole in one. Players have the choice of one of the benefits below.

Option 1 MGC will be provide 2 bottles of spirits; or 5 bottles of House wine; or an equivalent bar tab (\$150), which the member is responsible for sharing amongst other golfers in the Clubhouse after the completion of their round on that day. Players are responsible for payment of any shout that is beyond this allocation, and must pay on the day, or by arrangement with the Bar Manager.

Option 2 MGC will be provide \$150 on the house account of the golfer who got the Hole in one. This can be used in the Pro Shop or Café at any time within 12 months of the Hole In One.

Members from other clubs do not receive any contribution towards a shout.

To qualify for a trophy and inclusion on the Club Hole in One honours board the following conditions must be met:

- The hole in one was achieved by a member on this course during a complete round or during an official competition of lesser duration, and;
- The rules of golf governed play at the time, and;
- The Membership Manager informed asap (no more than 48 hours after the Hole In One)

Members scoring a hole in one on other courses will be compensated up to \$50 toward a shout at that club upon receipt of expenses.

Priority for Matches Continuing to 19th Hole

Any match going to the 19th hole commences from the 1st tee regardless of what tee the match commenced from. Players must be given right of way.

All times above are subject to other events being held.

Starting Tees: 1st & 10th tees only as permitted by the tee sheets.

Remember: Always check and book via the start sheets on the Club website, via the kiosk in the Cardroom or through the Dot Golf App. Even when competition play is on, there are usually tee times available for other members.

New members: New members are to be encouraged to participate in Club competitions. Members are to ensure they assist new members in becoming familiar with the Club.

Junior members: Restricted Juniors are not permitted to play on the course during main Club days (Saturdays 2:50 pm and Wednesdays until 3.30pm).

Tee times may be changed at the discretion of the GM and Match Committee.

Reciprocal Playing Rights During District Association Events

These rights are available only when the home course is being used for an event run by the Manawatu Wanganui District Golf Association or New Zealand Golf Association. Members are able to play at other Clubs within the Manawatu District. Qualifying events are as follows:

- Representative fixtures
- National fixtures
- Pennants (all grades)
- Designated Official tournaments (Shand Cup & Sybil Green, Glendinning Cup, Chamberlain

Shield & Gross Stableford Rosebowl). Both men's and ladies' events qualify.

It is the obligation of the player to make arrangements for play by contacting the Secretary/ Manager or Professional of the host Club, prior to arrival. Players must possess and present a membership card for the purpose of identification.

Reciprocating Clubs

Members of reciprocating Clubs are entitled to avail themselves of reciprocal privileges upon presentation of a note of introduction from the Membership Manager. Prior arrangements to play should be made.

INTERCLUB & REPRESENTATIVE COMPETITION

A number of factors determine a golf club's standing within the golfing fraternity and within the community. One of these factors is the performance of its representatives in interclub, inter-district and national events. Our Club has established a proud record of individual and team performances in its 125+ year history.

Selection of teams

Club representatives will be selected on a principle similar to that used for the Manawatu Wanganui



Golf Association teams, players who, in the opinion of the selectors, will deliver the best performances for the Club will be selected for representative teams.

Every Club member is eligible for selection in a Club team. The competitions range from the Pennant series for the most skilled golfers, the President's Trophy for golfers with handicap index's in the 5 to 22.4 handicap range, to the social interclub events.

To assist the selectors in forming their opinion, players seeking to represent our Club in interclub competitions, in particular non-handicap competition, may be required to:

- play in nominated trials during Jan/Feb,
- compete in the Tankard events which are ongoing trials,
- participate regularly in Club competitions,
- play in a proportion of nominated tournaments in the Manawatu Wanganui, and
- practice on a regular basis

Members who wish to be considered for the Club's representative teams should contact the General Manager who will provide further details.

CLUB COMPETITION AND TOURNAMENTS

Entering Club Competitions and Tournaments

All members are encouraged to enter Club competitions and tournaments run by the Club. Players need to enter the respective competitions by the due dates shown. 18 hole competitions and tournaments are open to all 18 hole members, 9 hole members are not permitted to play in 18 hole competitions or tournaments with the exception being, the Club's Opening and Closing Day.

Entering the 'Club Hagggle'

Members are encouraged to enter the Club Hagggle competitions which are run on most Club days. Entries are made in the Pro Shop.

Arranging Matches

It is the responsibility of all players to arrange the playing and completion of matches on or before the date set down by the Match Committee. **Please arrange and play your matches early.**

Should players or teams be unable to arrange with their opponents a mutually suitable time for playing a match they may, **10 days before the due completion date for the round**, apply to the Club Captain to have the Match Committee determine a time and date for play.

When a match has not been completed by the date specified the Match Committee will default both sides. **If any member is aware in advance that they will be unable to play any round of a competition by the dates set down in the programme book they should NOT enter the competition.**

All matches shall be played on the Manawatu Golf Club Course, except when the course is closed, whereby members have the option of playing a match on another course if both parties agree.

All matches in Club competitions shall be played over 18 holes except the finals for Senior, Intermediate and Junior Championships which shall be played over 36 holes on the day specified in the programme book.

Time extensions

It is expected all matches will be played by the due date. Any request for an extension must be in writing to the Match Committee for consideration. This includes all mixed, club competitions irrespective of what day the match is to be played.

Recording competition results

The winner is to record and enter the match result. Failure to do so will attract the same penalty as for an un-played match.

Results showing on the results sheets on the date of match completion shall stand. No later alteration is permitted.

Ties

Matches all square after completion of the stipulated round shall continue from No 1 tee irrespective of where the match was started, until one hole is won (strokes to be taken as applicable). Where players' scores are equal and where a playoff is not practical, in accordance with NZ Golf Association the winner will be decided by lot.

Protests

When it is intended to lodge a protest, the player shall, as well as complying with the rules of golf, notify a member of the Match Committee or Club Captain that he or she intends to protest. Unless this is done immediately after the completion of the game the protest will not be considered. In the absence of a member of the Match Committee or the Club Captain, the card should be marked "Protest".

Concurrent Stroke and Match Competitions

Concurrent Stroke and Match Competitions When stroke and match play competitions are played concurrently players must not vary or waive any conditions of the match play event to facilitate the play of the stroke event. Penalties (as provided for stroke events) incurred through the match play event must be counted in the stroke event.

Handicaps

In all par and Stableford competitions, and in match play, the full difference in handicaps is used.

Foursomes Rules

Mixed: Men hit off No. 1 tee and all odd numbered tees, ladies off even tees. 50% combined handicap index.

Canadian: Both players hit off tee, and the best drive is selected and played as in ordinary foursomes. 50% combined handicap index.
